Market Commentary

The Lusaka Stock Exchange All Share Index (LASI) excluding ZCCM-IH **gained** by **0.83%** w-o-w to close at 25,919.83 points.

In terms of turnover, the market closed at ZMW 13.36M (USD 602,869) over 637,188 shares traded, marking **a significant decrease** to last week's ZMW 28.61M (USD 1.29M) on 1.66M shares. The highest turnover contributor this week was CEC at 44.73%.

6,944 units traded this week for the market's listed REIT Real Estate USD recording a turnover of USD 625 (ZMW 13,819). Furthermore, no price action was recorded this week.

DCZM was the lead price gainer on the exchange recording an increase of ZMW **3.87** (USD 0.17) or roughly **21.50%** to close at ZMW 21.87 (USD 0.99). On the loss side, ZSUG dropped ZMW **-0.03** (USD 0.00) or approximately **-0.04%** closing at ZMW 66.97 (USD 0.99).

On the foreign exchange market, the Kwacha **Appreciated** against the following: EUR (1.97%), GBP (1.91%), USD (1.66%), and ZAR (1.02%).





ZCCM Further Cautionary

ZCCM Investments Holdings Plc (ZCCM-IH) issued a cautionary announcement regarding an ongoing transaction that may have a material effect on the price of the company's securities; This is in relation to a prior cautionary dated 06 August 2025 in which the full details are yet to be shared. SCBL Change in Directorate

Standard Chartered Bank Zambia PLC (SCZ) announced the appointment of Mr. Edward David Ng'andu as an Independent Non-Executive Director of the Board, effective 1st December 2025. Mr. Ng'andu is a distinguished Metallurgist and Zambian Mining Business Executive with a 37-year career in the Zambian Mining industry, including 16 years on the Konkola Copper Mines Plc (KCM) Executive Committee. The Board congratulated Mr. Ng'andu on his appointment and looks forward to his valuable contributions to the company.

Zambeef Products Plc announced the results of its Annual General Meeting held on 30 December 2025, where all resolutions were duly passed.

ZCCM Mopani Cautionary Withdrawal

ZCCM Investments Holdings Plc (ZCCM-IH) has announced the withdrawal of a cautionary announcement dated 26 June 2025. The Constitutional Court of Zambia has dismissed a petition challenging the 2024 Mopani transaction, which involved the acquisition of a 51% shareholding by Delta Mining Limited through a subscription for new shares. The Court ruled that the transaction was a corporate capital-raising exercise and did not amount to a sale, transfer, or disposal of existing Government-owned assets. As a result, shareholders are no longer required to exercise caution when dealing in their securities with regard to this particular matter, and the Cautionary Announcement is officially withdrawn.
